Strategic thinking and strong business acumen are essential in this role. We expect you to be well-versed in current information technology trends and familiar with business concepts. If you are also a stellar communicator and a proactive team player, we want you onboard.

Our priority is optimizing the user experience for our staff, students and members. To that end, the Director will engage employees and other stakeholders to stay informed on ISEP's technology needs and challenges. You will collaborate across departments to identify technology solutions that streamline our internal operations and augment our service delivery to ensure a positive customer experience.

- Oversee ISEP's technology infrastructure (networks and computer systems) and ensure its optimal performance. Audit the effectiveness of current systems and provide recommendations for enhancements.
- Build quality assurance and data protection processes. Design new security protocols.
- Collaborate with other departments to select and implement suitable technologies to streamline internal operations. Plan the implementation of IT solutions and provide guidance to the IT team and other ISEP staff. Communicate proactively about system enhancements and updates.
- Manage the IT budget and report on expenditures. Analyze the cost, value and risk of ISEP's IT systems and advise Senior Management on cost savings and risk mitigation options.
- Supervise ISEP's IT team members and external contractors. Provide coaching and actively manage performance.

- Broad knowledge of IT systems and infrastructure, with high proficiency in Microsoft SQL Server and ASP.NET technologies.
